About the Retreat: There's nothing more foolish than for people to think they know it all. Knowing what we don't know might lead to wisdom. This simple paradox underlies the whole of the human journey. Meditation allows us to be comfortable with uncertainty. In our present crisis this is a vital contemplative skill for us to learn and relearn. During this retreat Fr Laurence will introduce meditation to those who may be new to the practice and reintroduce it with fresh understanding to those who have been on this path for some time. Wherever we are on the contemplative path there will be an opportunity to experience some of the essential elements we need to grow through this crisis and to remain peaceful despite its many challenges. During this retreat we will be able to share the friendship and trust that grows out of being in silence together and understand why meditation creates community. The timings of the retreat are:

About the Retreat-giver: Fr Laurence is a Benedictine monk of the Monastery of Sta Maria di Pilastrello, Italy and Director of The World Community for Christian Meditation (WCCM). His spiritual teacher was Fr John Main. After the death of Fr Main in 1982, Fr Laurence continued to teach meditation which now has begun to develop a global community. In 1991, Fr Laurence established the International Centre of the WCCM in England, now present in more than a hundred countries. Bonnevaux in France is the new International Centre of the World Community for Christian Meditation.
