Non perishable food items can be donated after all Masses **THIS WEEKEND 6th /7th April 2024**. The food weighed in at 204.90 kgs for March collection.

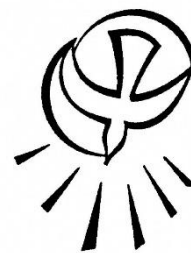
Your donations make a big difference to local people in crisis.
