Attentive to Mankind throughout History

The parable of the last judgement is Jesus' way of telling us that God has been attentive to mankind throughout history... He has been listening every time a beggar has begged – albeit in a low voice that could hardly be heard – and every time one of his children has asked for help.

Moreover, he will be judging us as to whether we have been attentive along with him. He will want to know if we have asked him to hear with his ears in order to know what our brothers and sisters are experiencing so we can help them, or if, on the contrary, we have deafened our ears by putting on earphones so as not to hear anybody.

Reflection: One of the biggest obstacles in the Christian walk is the idea that God is not with us. Since we can't see him, we imagine that he is far away and indifferent. God's mercy extends beyond the cross and into our everyday lives. Tell him what is on your heart and, even more, listen to what he has to say.
