The Parish Pastoral Council met on Tuesday, 13th May 2025

Based on Chapter 5 of 'Divine Renovation; From a Maintenance to a Missional Parish', we are examining how we might make our parish more welcoming and how we might make singing at Mass a better experience. Council noted the following:

- We have set up a 'Welcoming' sub-group to implement recommendations on making the Church Entrance more welcoming; developing the skills of the Welcoming Team; encouraging parishioners from different nationalities to become more involved in the parish; using social media as a communication tool; hospitality after Mass; developing further participation by parishioners in the Liturgy and showcasing the work of Parish Groups.
- We have also set up a 'Music At Mass' sub-group, comprising Council members, Parishioners and Musicians currently involved in this area, to clarify purpose and goals of singing at Mass, how we can improve congregational participation and how we can link with schools.

The success of the Alpha Experience, which finished on Thursday, 15th May, after a series of 11 evenings, was congratulated. 85 people had registered and attendance at most meetings was between 60 and 70.

A celebration of the experience is planned for Thursday 12th June.

Follow-up in September might include developing Parish Cell Groups where small groups talk about Faith and share personal experiences.
