Women of St Brigid's Walking Together


A walk through lent with Jesus and the women of the Gospel.

Saint Faustina records in her Diary the words **Jesus** spoke to her...

This is the hour of great mercy for the whole world. I will allow you to enter into my mortal sorrow. In this hour I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion.

At three o'clock, implore My Mercy, especially for sinners, and, if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony.

Encourage souls to say the Chaplet which I have given you. It pleases Me to grant everything they ask of Me by saying the Chaplet.

When this Chaplet is said in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person, not as a judge but as a Merciful Saviour.
