The Eucharist

A Mystery of life

The host is the bread of life. Receiving Christ's flesh, we receive his life. That life is the nourishment of our lives, not just new strength to restore the wear and tear of living, but the new energy and power that comes from the life of God himself.

Closely linked to this is the notion of our life with other people. As well as uniting us with Christ, the host unites us with all our brothers and sisters, because we are all one body in Christ. St Paul in particular underlines this aspect of the bread of life

(1Cor 10:16-17). Holy Communion is not only communion with Christ but communion with one another in him. In saying Amen to the body of Christ, says St. Augustine, we say Amen to what we are.


Archbishop Noël Treanor
