Marriages

At least 6 months' notice required prior to date of Marriage. Often young couples, because they are so busy preparing their future, overlook the importance of giving proper notice to the parish, they often do not realise that quite an amount of documentation has to be prepared.

Parents of young person getting married could perhaps draw their attention to this requirement. Thank you for your help.

Restrictions and Guidelines for attending Mass in St Brigid's

- **Face Coverings** are mandatory when entering and exiting the church and should be worn throughout services.
- Observe social distancing and use the sanitizer at the Church Entrance;
- Take a seat and remain there until the end of Mass; children must remain with their parents, and in the seat, at all times;
- Do not sit beside anyone who is not a member of your household;
- For those who wish to receive Holy Communion, remain in your seat and Holy Communion will be brought to you; Holy Communion is to be received in the hand;
- When leaving the Church follow the instructions and leave according to the indicated "One-way" system;
- **Anyone with cold-like symptoms or coughs must not enter the Church;**
- Those with underlying health issues are advised to remain at home;
- Toilet facilities are not available;

How would you have felt if you were in that boat?

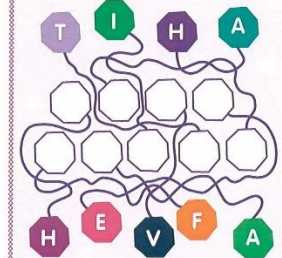

The disciples are happy now they know that Jesus can calm any storm.

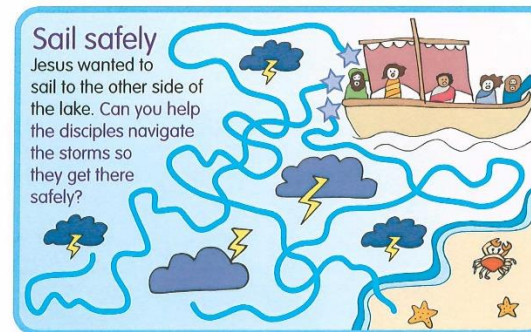
The disciples were very afraid in the storm. When Jesus calmed the storm, they were amazed.
