Many thanks again to all who have contributed to the collection and have set up new Standing Orders.


The collection currently stands at £29,186 including gift aid.

Sign of Hope

The number entering the Irish Seminary this year is 16 - it shows a slow growth: 2021 - 6; 2022 - 9; 2023 - 15; 2024 - 16. A further 18 are preparing to enter the seminary in 2025. It is indeed a sign of hope – but it will be many years before Ordinations. This total number currently studying for Diocesan Priesthood in Ireland is 45, in our Diocese of Down and Connor, 5 are preparing to enter the seminary in 2025; 1 entering this year, 2024; and 3 are currently studying for the priesthood. Keep praying for Vocations.

RCIA (the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) is a process to introduce the teachings of Jesus Christ and the Catholic Church to individuals who wish to learn more about Catholicism, including the opportunity, if they wish, to become Catholic through the Sacraments of Initiation.

RCIA is a time of teaching, formation and conversion to come to know, love and develop a relationship with God, the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
