Restrictions and Guidelines for attending Mass in St Brigid's

- **Face Coverings** are mandatory when entering and exiting the church and should be worn throughout services.
- Observe social distancing and use the sanitizer at the Church Entrance;
- Take a seat and remain there until the end of Mass; children must remain with their parents, and in the seat, at all times;
- Do not sit beside anyone who is not a member of your household;
- For those who wish to receive Holy Communion, remain in your seat and Holy Communion will be brought to you; Holy Communion is to be received in the hand;
- When leaving the Church follow the instructions and leave according to the indicated "One-way" system;
- **Anyone with cold-like symptoms or coughs must not enter the Church;**
- Those with underlying health issues are advised to remain at home;
- Toilet facilities are not available;

Covid-19 and seating arrangement in St Brigid's Church.

With each passing weekend it is obvious that more and more parishioners wish to return to Sunday Mass. With good management we have gradually opened the Church to accommodate as many as possible, while observing the health regulations.

SIDE ISLES

PLEASE NOTE: The seats on the Side Isles are "multi-occupancy", and is reserved for families, or for those in a "bubble". These seats hold 6 persons. Single persons or couples are asked to use the seating in the Centre Isles.

CENTRE ISLES

The seating arrangement in the Centre Isles has changed slightly. Every other row accommodates TWO persons at either end of the bench. However, the formally closed seats are now open, but the seating is reserved for the centre of the bench only – please note that you must not sit at the ends of these benches.

The seats available for occupancy are marked with a **green tick**; those unavailable are marked with a **red X**.

Please follow the directions of the Stewards.



The capacity of the Church is now increased to 275. Until such time as the Church is fully open, it is always possible that there may not be seats available for some parishioners. We ask that you to wait in the porch, or outside the Church, and assure you that Holy Communion will be brought to you. We are doing everything possible to ensure that those coming to St Brigid's feel welcome.



The Holy Spirit shows us how much God the Father loves us. God loves you more than you could ever imagine.




Draw a picture under the umbrella of God's love, all the people who love you.
