
Wednesday 29th June Feast of STs Peter and Paul

Peter recovered this trust when Jesus said to him three times: "Feed my sheep" (Jn 21:15-17). Peter thrice confessed his love for Jesus, thus making up for his threefold denial of Christ during the Passion.

Peter still regrets the disappointment which he caused the Lord on the night of his betrayal. Now that the Lord asks him: "Do you love me?" Peter does not trust himself and his own strength, but instead entrusts himself to Jesus and his mercy: "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you" (Jn 21:17). Precisely at this moment, fear, insecurity, and cowardice dissipate. Peter experienced how God's fidelity is always greater than our acts of infidelity, stronger than our denials.

Reflection: *What fears, insecurities, and cowardice toward the Lord do you take to prayer? trust in God's fidelity. Tell him, Lord you know everything; you know that I love you. Have confidence in his love for you. Trust in his mercy.*



ST BRIGID'S PARISH **SACRISTAN (Part-time)**

A vacancy has arisen for a Sacristan within St Brigid's Parish. This would be a permanent appointment requiring 16 hours attendance each week (work pattern to be agreed). Ability to work flexible hours is required from the post holder from time to time. Rate of Pay - £9.50 gross per hour.

Responsibilities in the role will include:

- ✚ The maintenance of the sacristy where the church's liturgical items are kept including vestments, sacred vessels, and books etc.
- ✚ Ensuring that the sanctuary is set up for mass, other services, baptisms, and funerals, ensuring all the requisite books and sacramental vessels etc. are in place, and that afterwards the sanctuary is cleared, and the church is left secure and tidy.
