Restrictions and Guidelines for attending Mass in St Brigid's

- **Face Coverings** are mandatory when entering and exiting the church and should be worn throughout services.
- Observe social distancing and use the sanitizer at the Church Entrance;
- Take a seat and remain there until the end of Mass; children must remain with their parents, and in the seat, at all times;
- Do not sit beside anyone who is not a member of your household;
- For those who wish to receive Holy Communion, remain in your seat and Holy Communion will be brought to you; Holy Communion is to be received in the hand;
- When leaving the Church follow the instructions and leave according to the indicated "One-way" system;
- **Anyone with cold-like symptoms or coughs must not enter the Church;**
- Those with underlying health issues are advised to remain at home;
- Toilet facilities are not available;

How can I become a Catholic?

Becoming Catholic means undertaking a spiritual journey. The time this journey takes depends on the readiness of each individual. The process is called the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults*, or **RCIA** for short, and there are ceremonies or "rites" at each stage to signify the steps along the way.

Generally new members of the Church are received at Easter each year. They are received either through Baptism, Confirmation and First Holy Communion, or simply received and confirmed if they have been previously baptised in another Christian tradition.

You may simply wish to make some general enquiries at this stage, and you are most welcome to do so. You are also most welcome to attend Mass with our Parish Community.

You can either:

- contact a Catholic parish in your area
- speak to the Priest or Deacon before or after Mass
- or make contact with the Parish through the Parish Office.

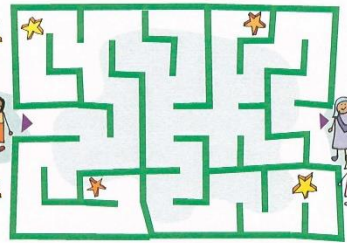
The disciples went up a mountain.

Go, make disciples

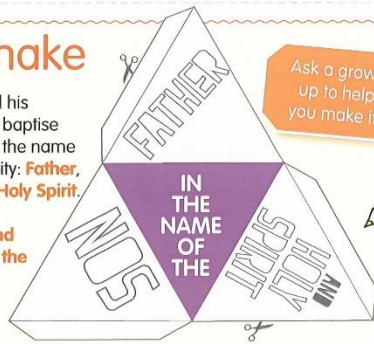
Jesus asked the disciples share his message of love. Guide the disciples to their friends so they can tell them about Jesus.
