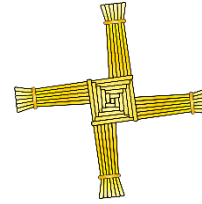

St Brigid's support to the South Belfast foodbank makes a huge difference to the lives of people living in poverty.

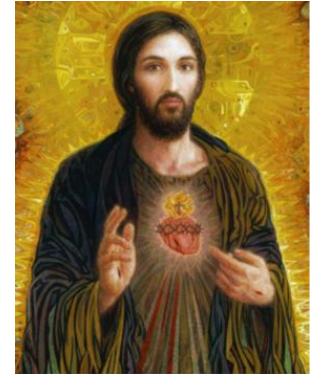
Non perishable food items can be donated after all Masses on the **6th/7th June 2026**. The May collection weighed in at 203.2kgs.
