Funerals, Weddings and Baptisms

FUNERALS

The Maximum number that can attend a funeral service will be determined by the size and circumstances of the venue, whilst facilitating social distancing and observing safety guidelines. Therefore, the number attending funeral rites in the church may be permitted up to the capacity of the church determined when you carried out the risk assessment for the recommencement of Mass and Sacraments. The Executive guidance indicates that the maximum number who may attend the committal at the graveside or doors of the crematorium is capped to 30 persons.

WEDDINGS

Indoor marriage ceremonies can resume from Friday 10th July. The number of persons attending the wedding may be up to the capacity determined for the Church for the celebration of Mass following all requirements in relation to hygiene and social distancing.

Currently maximum capacity is 70 persons for St Brigid's Church.
